

**Minutes of the General Purposes Committee Meeting GP 10/14 of
Kingsclere Parish Council held at 7.30pm on
Monday 6th October 2014 in the Village Club**

- 10/14.1 Apologies:** Cllrs Denness; Peach; Savin:
- 10/14.2 Declaration of Interest:** None
- 10/14.3 Matters arising from Minutes of GP Meeting 8th September 2014**
- GP 09/14.4:** New catalogues for xmas lights have been obtained. Cllr Farey to contact AB for input. **MF**
- GP 09/14.5.ii:** Tree Wardens have inspected all trees on the Holding Field and suggest no action required except to cut lower branches from large Sycamore causing problems for the Tennis Club – Clerk to get quote for this work only. **Clerk**
- GP 09/14.6.ii:** Volunteer of the Year Awards moved to 12th December so as not to clash with FKS Fireworks display. **JS**
- GP 09/14.6.ii:** It was agreed to purchase Book Tokens for retiring Brian Dixon and ask him to buy books of his own choosing but bring them to Awards evening for formal presentation. Also to arrange a Certificate for presentation. **Clerk**
- 10/14.4 Speed Watch:**
Cllr Bond provided update. Two people have withdrawn. We are waiting for Police to approve volunteers and suggested roads list. PCSO has been designated as our area Co-ordinator but she is leaving in January 2015. Funding requirements were discussed:
- A Recess was proposed and accepted to allow Mr Paul Watson a member of the Speed Watch Team to speak:**
PW proposed that signage be purchased to be posted at entrances to the village to warn people that they are entering a Speed Watch Area. Speed Watch is primarily about deterring speeding, not just trying to catch people speeding, therefore, signage on existing poles could be effective. Traffic Orders will probably need to be obtained for such signage – we will need to contact HCC. **Clerk**
- Out of Recess:**
It was proposed by Cllr Bond; seconded by Cllr Sawyer and unanimously **agreed** that we apply at OM for further funding from EVTF for signage or failing agreement contribute funding through GP Budget. Approx cost £250 Clerk to proceed with grant application from P & C Commissioner **Clerk/OM**
- 10/14.5 Request for litter bin at Hook Road:**
Due to absence of Cllr Peach this item held over to the next meeting. **NP**
- 10/14.6 Under 18's Football Boot Camp:**
A summary of the situation was provided by the KYFC Chairman. It was agreed that we consent to their requested use of the Holding Field without charge. It was also agreed that they be asked to tidy up or remove storage container. We have had sight of their Insurance Cover. **Clerk**
