Making a Difference Awards 2021

This year's award ceremony will take place at the Bounce Back Day being held at the Fieldgate Centre on Saturday 14th August. Thanks, and warmest congratulations to all those who have been nominated and who will receive awards. The Parish Council wish to thank everyone who has contributed to the village and has Made a Difference.

Reminder – Keep hedges trimmed

A gentle reminder during this lovely warm weather (at the time of writing!) that this is also prime growing weather. Please ensure that hedges are kept tidy and under control, especially if they are by a road or path. Thank you.

Volunteers for Tree Wardens

Thank you to those who have come forward and are interested in being involved. It's not too late please do get in touch if you would like to learn more.

The village currently has two volunteer tree wardens, and KPC would welcome more support for this scheme. The Tree Wardens scheme was set up by the Tree Council in association with local councils who appoint voluntary tree wardens to gather information, give advice, and encourage practical projects relating to trees in the community. No experience is necessary - just enthusiasm for trees and the local environment. Tree Warden tasks include being eyes and ears for the Parish Council on anything tree related, checking applications for work on trees with Tree Protection Orders (TPOs) or in conservation areas, doing surveys of trees and hedges, tree planting schemes and really anything else that the Tree Warden feels might be useful to the parish. Periodically in the past Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council has run one day courses to bring people up to speed on subjects such as trees and the law but clearly that has not been possible recently. Sometimes other courses are notified to the Parish Council. If you would be interested in becoming a Tree Warden, please contact the Parish Council.

Recycling Bins and Glass Recycling

The collections dates are 11th & 28th August and 8th September.

NEXT PARISH COUNCIL MEETING – The council do not meet during August but is still contactable using the normal methods. The next meeting will be at 7:30pm on Monday 27th September 2021, in the Village Club. As mentioned previously we may need to continue with the distancing and other rules for another month, but we will also endeavour to put precautions in place as good practice going forward to continue everyone's efforts. We welcome the attendance of parishioners at our meetings and anyone who wishes to raise any matters of concern will be given the opportunity to do so.



Kingsclere Cricket Club



Starting the 2021 Season on a High!

Half way through July and the league cricket season is at it's midpoint. And, on the back of promotion in the last "proper" season (2019) KCC are going well in Hampshire North Division 4.

The club managed to get to the end of June undefeated! 6 wins from 6 matches played! The absolute highlight was the match against Basingstoke VI. The club batted first, scored a league record 437 for the loss of only 3 wickets and then proceeded to bowl Basingstoke out for 108. The batting highlight was Ed Lyle (of the Bel and Dragon at the Swan) who smacked the bowling to all corners of the ground in hitting 263 not out - another league record and, unsurprisingly, the highest score in amateur league cricket that week. Ross Andrews backed Ed up with 78 in a massive first wicket partnership (and he's not far behind Ed in total runs scored with 323 to Ed's 344).

Ed followed up his Saturday innings with 162 not out the following Monday in the 18 overs a side Cyril Thompson memorial knock out competition at Basingstoke.

Club skipper Steve Hanney's 99 not out, to lead the team to victory in the local derby against East Woodhay is another highlight of note. And good batting has to be backed up by good bowling and fielding. Best of the bowling performances so far is Aiden Ferris' 4 for 22 (also against Basingstoke).

The club's U17 team are also enjoying their cricket with a record of played 2, won 1, lost 1 (and that was a mighty close affair which could have gone either way). They currently sit just above mid table in their first season of U17 cricket.

The key to success so far this season, as previously, is the great spirit in which the club plays cricket - play to enjoy and play to win!

At 12th July, the club is sitting 5th in the league (of 18) with a record of Played 8, Won 6. Fingers crossed for the second half of the season.

August In The Garden

After the unusual wet weather this summer we look forward to a warmer August, which often can become sultry. July's weather did damage to the flowerbeds and borders, and produced a huge amount of growth to trees and shrubs, and not forgetting the weeds. When the weather is fine, many of the shrubs and hedges will-need to be cut back, probably for the second time this year.

There seems to plenty of black fly and ants around this year; soapy water can combat the blackfly as an alternative to chemicals. Hot water I'm told can be used on ants, but I'm not sure if it works. We had a lot of frogspawn in our garden this year, so I'm hoping that some frogs have survived, and that the frogs will hopefully munch their way through the slug population. Hoeing can help the weeds, but without the sun to dry out the uprooted weeds they soon start to grow again so I'm afraid only pulling them up by hand can get the job done.

Ponds need attention; if leaves rot in the water they can encourage algae. As the weather hopefully warms up, the water will need topping up to compensate for evaporation.

When feeding the lawn in late summer use a fertilizer high in phosphate. This should help the grass to toughen up for the winter months, giving stronger root growth. The grass still needs to be cut regularly; grass clippings can be left on the lawn in dry weather acting as a mulch for the grass, helping to retain moisture.

Roses continue to need to be dead headed. I cut away some of the stem too, as this keeps the bushes tidy and encourages new growth.

Lavender will need to be trimmed, any old flower spikes can be removed by using a pair of hand shears. This will encourage side shoots keeping the plant compact. Lavender rarely grows again from old wood. When plants become old and straggly, take cuttings or replace with new plants, remembering that if your soil is clay incorporate some coarse grit to improve drainage which the plants will enjoy.

Nature Notes

We had a close look at our village lake recently and were pleased to see how clear the water was. Unlike recent times the lake bottom had more healthy looking vegetation sprouting in various places. There have been times when it had looked barren. Looking from the bridge towards the source there is further plant life, a dark green mat of luxurious growth that looks suspiciously alien and has all the signs of an aquatic pest.

The fortunes of the lake have waxed and waned over time, many older residents would remember a shoal of carp that would patrol the deeper water and other times when good sized trout would appear to contest with the ducks for bread.

Final note on terns for this year, a successful breeding season with three pairs and young. The raft needs some TLC.

A small bumble type bee with a golden body hovering among plants seemed more interested in bare soil than in flowers. Some species of bee nest in burrows and this one could be looking for its home but NO. Landing for an instant it picked up a minute stem of dried plant material and flew off with it in some or all of its feet. Back it came to find another load but this was overlarge, it was dropped and the bee vanished.

A range of flat roofed garages nearby appear to have been bombed with mustard, patches of bright yellow stand out against the grey roofing material. This is biting stonecrop, a species of sedum which can flourish on the driest, barest surface and in full sun.


