Matters arising: None Review of RDRC Create for 2010/20. The clark confirmed there would be no support	
<b>Review of BDBC Grants for 2019/20:</b> The clerk confirmed there would be no support grant for the next financial year. The confirmed grants the Parish Council will receive are	
£2040 for the closed cemetery, £3094 for grass cutting and it is estimated that it will receive	
£6403 for the litter warden.	
<b>To Identify Items for the Reserves:</b> After a short discussion it was agreed that a nominal	
sum of £10,000 would be allocated to phase 2 of the Holding Field development, £3,500 for	
speed monitoring equipment, £2000 for oak trees, and £1,500 for the cemetery - pending	
discussion at the January OM – would be allocated from reserves.	
Review of Cashflow and Budget Forecast: Document circulated prior to meeting. It was	
queried as to why the Pony Paddock is expected to be overbudget by 100%. It was	
explained that it is due to new fencing and gates being required as well as additional fruit	
trees being purchased with incoming grant money. It was agreed that 10 <sup>th</sup> December would	
be the deadline for any other expenses claims from those involved with the "Lest We	
Forget" show. Review of 2019/2020 Precept Requirements: Document circulated prior to meeting. It	
was agreed that the clerk would revise the budget figure for the Pony Paddock to include	Clerk
funds for the extra grass cuts agreed at previous GP meeting. It was also agreed that the	OICIN
training budget would be increased by £500 to a total of £1000 due to increased	
employees. The Neighbourhood Plan section of the budget is to be removed	
CCLA Public Sector Deposit Fund and Local Authorities Property Fund: It was	
considered that the Parish Council move to a new bank account that pays interest. It was	
mentioned that with current interest rates so low, it would not be worth the admin. It was	
decided that, at this time, the Parish Council would not persue.
