- 05/13.1 To Elect a Chairman:**

- 05/13.3 Matters arising from Minutes of GP Meeting on 8<sup>th</sup> April 2013:**  
**04/13.3.i:** Letter of thanks had been sent to Dr Lucas for his survey and expert advice on the Wild Flower Meadow at the Dell Recreation Ground.
