

## Kingsclere Parish Council Grants Policy

Kingsclere Parish Council regularly makes grants to organisations which provide a benefit to Kingsclere residents. These may be made:

- To Charities
- To Village organisations
- For Special projects of various kinds
- 1. In each year, the council sets a budget for the giving of grants and sets a maximum amount for grants to any one organisation, currently £250 except in very special circumstances.
- 2. It is expected that organisations will attempt to fund their own activities and will approach the Parish Council for a grant only to support exceptional expenditure. Grants will not generally be given for running costs.
- **3.** Grants are not, except in the most exceptional circumstances, made to individuals, nor will they be made to businesses.
- **4.** Any organisation making an application must be prepared to provide up to date accounts, and it would be expected that applicants would also search for other sources of finance.
- **5.** Applicants must be prepared, if requested to do so, to attend the meeting at which the grant application will be considered.
- **6.** Applications must demonstrate the benefit to the community.
- **7.** Applications for grants must be made on the appropriate form and submitted with the necessary supporting documents.
- **8.** Applications must be made in advance of any financial commitments being given to third parties.
- **9.** The giving of a grant in one financial year should not in any way commit the council to making a grant in any subsequent year.
